Sister Frances Prince receives her Eternal Reward

Frances Elizabeth Prince, Evangelist and former Pastor of Druids Heath Church, Birmingham, England was born in Clarendon, Jamaica on June 4, 1930 and went home to be with the Lord on May 16, 2015.

From an early age, Frances had a keen interest in church. She would take clay from the yard outside her house and make little drums so that she could have service. Frances would always be the preacher. Her Mother used to send her to the Baptist Church, where she would attend Sunday School with her three other sisters, but she did not enjoy the services. She often testified that she used to think to herself "If every church is right, why aren't they saying the same thing?"

As Frances grew, there was a preacher that came into her district. She always felt the unction to put out chairs and flowers and help with tracking the songs for the minister.

On 22nd December 1953 Frances Elizabeth Maddix became Frances Elizabeth Prince, marrying Samuel Nathaniel Prince. They left the sunny climates of Jamaica in 1954 to travel to England.

Upon arrival and settling in Birmingham, Sister Prince found it difficult to find a church and would cry. Soon, some people came from a neighbouring city to Birmingham and held tent meetings which she attended. This gathering moved to Mary Street, Balsall Heath and was known as the New Testament Church of God. After a period of worshipping in school halls, homes and visiting other churches, Sis Prince and a friend heard a rumour about a church, two bus journeys away. As they entered the door "It was like steam coming out of the saucepan, it was very hot" Sister Prince said. They loved what they saw and wanted to be a part of it. This was the Church of God of Prophecy.

Sis Prince occupied various offices within the Church such as, Sunday School Teacher, ABM leader, WMB leader, District Sunday School Superintendent, Evangelist and generally made herself available to work for God and His Church. In the early eighties, Sis Prince experienced a calling on her life and in 1985 a Sunday School was started and then later a Church organized in Druids Heath, Birmingham. Pastor Prince had a heart for people and a burden for souls. Under Pastor Prince's ministry, many souls were saved and witnessed to. Due to ill health, Pastor F. E Prince retired on Sunday 22nd February 2015 after almost 30 years' service. We salute Sister Prince for the marvelous example she has set us all. We'll meet you in the morning Sister Prince.
